Our theme for today: Even when you don't understand, Jesus Loves You!

## **Ingredients:**

Glove Candies Popcorn

## **Snack Assembly:**



 Take a plastic glove, and drop one fruit snack into the tip of each finger (and the thumb).



- The sweet fruit snacks remind us that our actions—the way we treat others—should be sweet, kind, and good. That's the way we want to be treated, and that's the way Jesus tells us to treat others. Ask Crew members to discuss:
- (?) When is a time when someone did something really sweet for you?
- : Sometimes there are things around us that are so wonderful and amazing and big that we can't understand how God could make them. Share an example of something in nature that's amazing to you, such as huge mountains or how our bodies work. Those things are God Sightings, because God is the one who made all those incredible, awesome, unbelievable, mysterious things! Think of something you've seen around you that is so incredible you just don't understand how it works or how it's made. Write kids' God Sightings on a God Sightings Tracks sticker.
